Purpose:

This program has come about due to many requests from our previous students. Students will participate in several scenarios including: fires in the basement, fires on the first floors, fires on the second floor, fires in the attic, search, rescue, exposure protection, forcible entry, venting, team status report, Mayday, firefighter down and RIT deployment. Prior to attending students MUST have gained competency in the following subjects: Safety & Orientation, SCBAs, Fire Streams, Fire Hose and Fire Behavior. A letter from the students Fire Chiefs confirming this must be provided prior to the student attending. You are required to bring your own WCB approved personal protective clothing. SCOTT breathing apparatus will be supplied or you may use your own.

Intent:

The one-day program is designed to sharpen the skills of the experienced firefighter. A great refresher using structure fires only. The course will be led by 4 instructors and will include a Rehab Officer. For more information regarding the Rehab protocols please contact 100 Mile House Fire-Rescue.
